The Best Field Trip You'll Ever Have

Kids love us because we love to have fun at Dream Field Farms. You'll love us because we are dedicated to educating your students with hands on activities. We combine learning and fun in one memorable experience.

There are a variety of exciting and educational adventures waiting for your class at the farm. Each class will visit the following areas on the farm:

Animal Barn: Your class will visit our animal barn where they will meet donkey, pigs, sheep, goats, chickens, cows, turkeys, ducks and rabbits. Each child is given corn to feed the animals, and we begin our discussion on food sources. A lot of children have never encountered farm animals, so we have an additional host stationed at the animal barn to answer questions and to insure that the children can interact with the animals.

Learning Center: We change the learning center every year, so even if your students have already been to the farm, they'll have a new educational experience. This year we're making butter! During this process a host will discuss different foods and where they come from. For example, we will explain that cows make milk and from milk we can make butter, ice cream, cheese, etc. We will then talk about the animals the kids see on the farm and what foods come from these animals. Then, the students take turns milking Maybelle the milk cow. Maybelle is not a real cow but has teats similar to a real cow that the kids will "milk" and water comes out. They will also be given cups of cream to churn butter. The kids will visit a working vegetable garden. Most children have never seen food grow, so the garden is helpful in explaining the process of growing food.



Inflatable Playground: The kids can get a little energy out at our play area and inflatable playground. Kids love this area because it is fantasy fun land!

Corn Maze: Your students will also tour the corn maze, ending at marshmallow mountain, a hay mountain with slides and tunnels.



Pumpkin Patch: A hayride to our pumpkin patch is also in store for your group. The hayride includes music and dancing, and everyone has a great time! When we arrive at the pumpkin patch each child receives a complimentary, small pumpkin. On the way back, they'll get to see our working beehive and learn about how honey is made and why bees are important at the Patch!

Cow Train: The kids will ride the cow train, jump in the corn, race rubber ducks and ride pedal tractors! What more could a kid want from a day on the farm?

World Famous Hurdling Pigs: Most farms have racing pigs, but at Dream Field we like to go that extra mile. Our pigs hurdle hay! Yup, you read correctly. Dream Field Farms is home to the world famous hay hurdling pigs. This is entertaining for everyone!
